Every horse and pony placed 1st in all In Hand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions and Reserves will qualify for the Champion and Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

Please Note – It is not the Secretaries or the Judges responsibility to ensure competitors reach their classes on time, it is at the Judges discretion if late entries are allowed to enter the ring.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Owners entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to Carnwath Agricultural Society.
- No exhibitor may enter and compete an animal under a Judge who is known to have sold, bred or produced the animal.
- Colts, 2 year old and over must be bitted and handled by an attendant 16 years and over.
- The JUDGES and SECRETARIES decision is FINAL in all matters.
- Any disputes shall be decided by the Show Committee whose decision is final and binding in all Parties. All protests must be lodged in writing with the Secretary along with the sum of £15.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is not upheld.
